



Official Statement for Authorized Vehicles At Cynosport 2016

For Everyone's Safety

- Respect and abide by posted showground access hours.
 - Service trucks, forklifts, and other operations can be placed in operation at any time.
 - Daily clean-up and other preparations are required to make ready for each day. Time is
 of the essence and unauthorized traffic may interfere unexpected in those operations.
- Keep all transportation vehicles, motorized and non-motorized, on authorized roadways and in parking lots (including RV lots) at all times. Only the following vehicles will be allowed on the polo field Tuesday through Sunday, Nov. 8 – 13:
 - o Official Cynosport® and West World of Scottsdale staff operations carts
 - Mobile vehicles for the disabled (e.g., wheelchairs, power chairs, and scooters). Golf
 carts may be used only with a permit, which may be issued at USDAA's sole discretion
 upon presentation of a current motorized vehicle "hang tag" or similar proof of disabled
 motorized vehicle licensing status.
- Exercise extreme caution when traversing the south perimeter road (i.e., Polo Field Way).
 - This is a limited access service drive and visibility can be limited and traffic can be congested at unexpected times.
- West World of Scottsdale and USDAA reserve the right to further restrict areas in which motorized and non-motorized vehicles may operate or be parked.
 - Safety for all is paramount.
