



2016 Cynosport® World Games Competitor Information

Thank you for entering this year's Cynosport World Games! We're thrilled to be back in Scottsdale and want to make this year's event the best one yet! Here are a few reminders about WestWorld and how the event will work this year. Please read it carefully.

HELPFUL TIPS

- WestWorld has strict policies prohibiting smoking and alcohol on the show grounds. Smoking and outside
 alcohol is not permitted on the show grounds at any time. Alcohol may be purchased from the vendor
 throughout the event.
- Please do not enter the show site each day until the doors are officially open. We are busy preparing for the day's activities to ensure a smooth running event.
- Listen for announcements and sign up for Event Emails on the Cynosport website for any changes to the schedule. The walk and run schedules will also be posted ringside and in the crating area. Course maps will be available at a designated, central location each morning and on Cynosport.com
- Please wear your wristbands! This allows you and your family access to the competition and crating areas which are separated from the general public access.
- Only official Cynosport staff carts and handicapped-permitted carts are allowed on the polo fields. Please register for a handicap cart permit at check-in.
 - Personal, motorized vehicles and golf carts may be used to go back and forth between your car/RV but they must remain outside of the show grounds.
- Remember to keep valuables out of plain sight at all times.
- Please support our vendors! Competitors can only sell or provide services on the show grounds if they are an official vendor of the event.

LOADING/UNLOADING

- Competitors may unload their gear starting at **2:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Nov. 8** and after 6 a.m. the rest of the week.
- Please bring your dollies!

PARKING

- Competitor parking is located in Lot C, the north parking lot between Monterra and the big tent (see map)
- Event parking passes will be available for sale during check-in on Tuesday for \$25 and include in/out privileges.
- If you are checking in on Wednesday, you may still purchase an event parking pass from the parking attendant, but you must ask to purchase the event pass.
- Otherwise, WestWorld charges a daily rate of \$5 per day to park which does not include in/out privileges.

CRATING

- Reserved crating opens at 2:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Nov. 8th. Please bring your dollies!
- Personal shade canopies may be set up for individual crating in the designated area only.
- WestWorld policies restrict the use of mats/ground covers in the either the reserved or individual crating areas.
- Overnight camping is not permitted.
- Please crate only in your designated kennel area for the safety of your dog(s).
 - o If you are running multiple dogs, you may bring a crate to the ring only when your group runs.
- Please do not change your crating space without notifying the crating coordinator. We need this information to find you in case of emergency.

EXERCISE AREAS

- Dogs may be exercised off-leash in the designated area only. Remember to pick up after your dog.
- Please avoid having your dog potty on tents, trash cans, tables, chairs, etc. We know accidents can happen, so please clean it up immediately and notify us if you need assistance.
