Remember, USDAA rules state for all tournament events - you <u>must</u> check-in before your first run. You are encouraged to check-in as early as possible or you may encounter walk-through conflicts. Unfortunately, we will not able to accommodate special walk-throughs.

CHECK-IN

- Competitor Check-In is in Tent 6 Check-In/LAA between rings 3 & 4 (see map)
- You are encouraged to Check-In on Tuesday to receive your wristbands to access the kenneling area
- If you plan to Check-In on Wednesday, please come to Check-In BEFORE going to your kennel area to set up.
 - Wristbands will be required to access kenneling starting on Wednesday morning.
- The Competitor Check-in area is small, so **please** leave your dogs in their kennels when checking in.
- Remember, you must check-in to confirm you are competing and if your team/pair is still intact.
- We'll also have other goodies for you and will pass along any new information you'll need for the event.
- We encourage you to check-in on Tuesday so you can enjoy the Competitor Appreciation of Fry Bread!

GROUP ASSIGNMENTS & ROTATION

- Everyone is randomly assigned a group. All jump heights may not be in each group.
- Remember to look at the jump heights in each ring and then find your group rotation. Jump heights within groups may be separated into different rings. So you may run the same course in different rings depending on your dog's jump height and if they are entered in Championship, Performance or Veterans classes.
- Please be ready at ringside when your group is scheduled to run. Competitors MUST run in their assigned position in the run order for the run to count. If you are not present when called for your run i.e. you miss your turn in order you can run at the end of the jump height within the group; however, the run will be scored as an ELIMINATION.
- Remember to listen to announcements and sign up for <u>Email Alerts</u> on the <u>Cynosport website</u> for any scheduling changes.
- When your group's rotation is done for the day, we'd love to have you volunteer ringside, visit the vendors, enjoy the other dog activities on the show grounds or hangout in Competitor Hospitality.

NOTE: WestWorld has strict policies prohibiting smoking and alcohol on the show grounds. Smoking and outside alcohol is **not permitted** on the show grounds at any time. Alcohol may be purchased from the vendor throughout the event. Thank you for your cooperation in abiding by these policies.
