

2018 Cynosport® World Games Arrival and Crating



GENERAL INFORMATION

- Please note: WestWorld does not allow smoking or outside alcohol on the show grounds at any time.
- Listen for announcements and sign up for <u>Event Emails</u> on the <u>Cynosport website</u> for any changes to the schedule. The walk and run schedules will also be posted ringside and in the crating area.
- Please wear your wristbands! This allows you and your family access to the competition and crating areas which are separated from the general public access. Additional wristbands may be requested at check-in.
- Please support our vendors! Only official vendors may sell or provide services on the show grounds.

LOADING/UNLOADING

- Competitors may unload their gear starting at 1 pm on Tuesday, October 30 and at 7 am the rest of the week.
- Please bring your dollies! Competitor parking is on a paved area of the polo field opposite kenneling. Please refer to the map link in <u>Competitor Information 2018</u> on the Cynosport website.
- Please do not enter the show site each day until the site is officially open.

PARKING

- Event parking passes will be available during check-in on Tuesday for \$25 and include in/out privileges.
- On Wednesday, you may purchase an event parking pass from the parking attendants. Ask for the event pass.
- Single day passes may be purchased for \$5 per day and do not include in/out privileges.

CRATING

- Reserved crating opens at 1 pm on Tuesday, October 30th. Please bring your dollies!
- Personal shade canopies may be set up for individual crating in the open areas within the fenced kennel area.
- WestWorld policies restrict the use of mats/ground covers on the grass in reserved kenneling or personal crating areas.
- Overnight camping is not permitted.
- Please crate only in your designated kennel area for the safety of your dog(s). If you are running multiple dogs, you may bring a crate to the ring only when your group runs.
- Please do not change your crating space without notifying the crating coordinator. We need this information to find you in case of emergency.

 On site, please see the staff at the check-in tent.

CARTS AND MOBILITY ACCESS

- Pedal bikes, motorized wheelchairs & chairs are allowed on the polo fields.
- Only official Cynosport staff carts and handicapped-permitted carts are allowed on the polo fields. Please register for a mobility cart permit at check-in.
- Motorized vehicles and golf carts without handicapped permits may be used to go back and forth between your car/RV but they must remain on East Polo Field way where the RVs are parked.

EXERCISE AREAS

- Dogs may be exercised off-leash within the kennel area ONLY.
- Remember to pick up after your dog.
- Please avoid having your dog potty on tents, trash cans, tables, chairs, etc. We know accidents can happen, so please clean it up immediately and notify us if you need assistance.

SAFETY REMINDERS

- Remember to keep valuables out of plain sight at all times.
- Arizona is a natural habitat for snakes and scorpions. Please walk with care in natural areas and when moving items that have been piled or stacked—as you may find a friend.
