### **Briefing Notes**

#### **Dog Agility Team Relay**

- White Circles 1-12
- Black Circles 1-11 (odd-height dog)\*
- White Squares 1-10

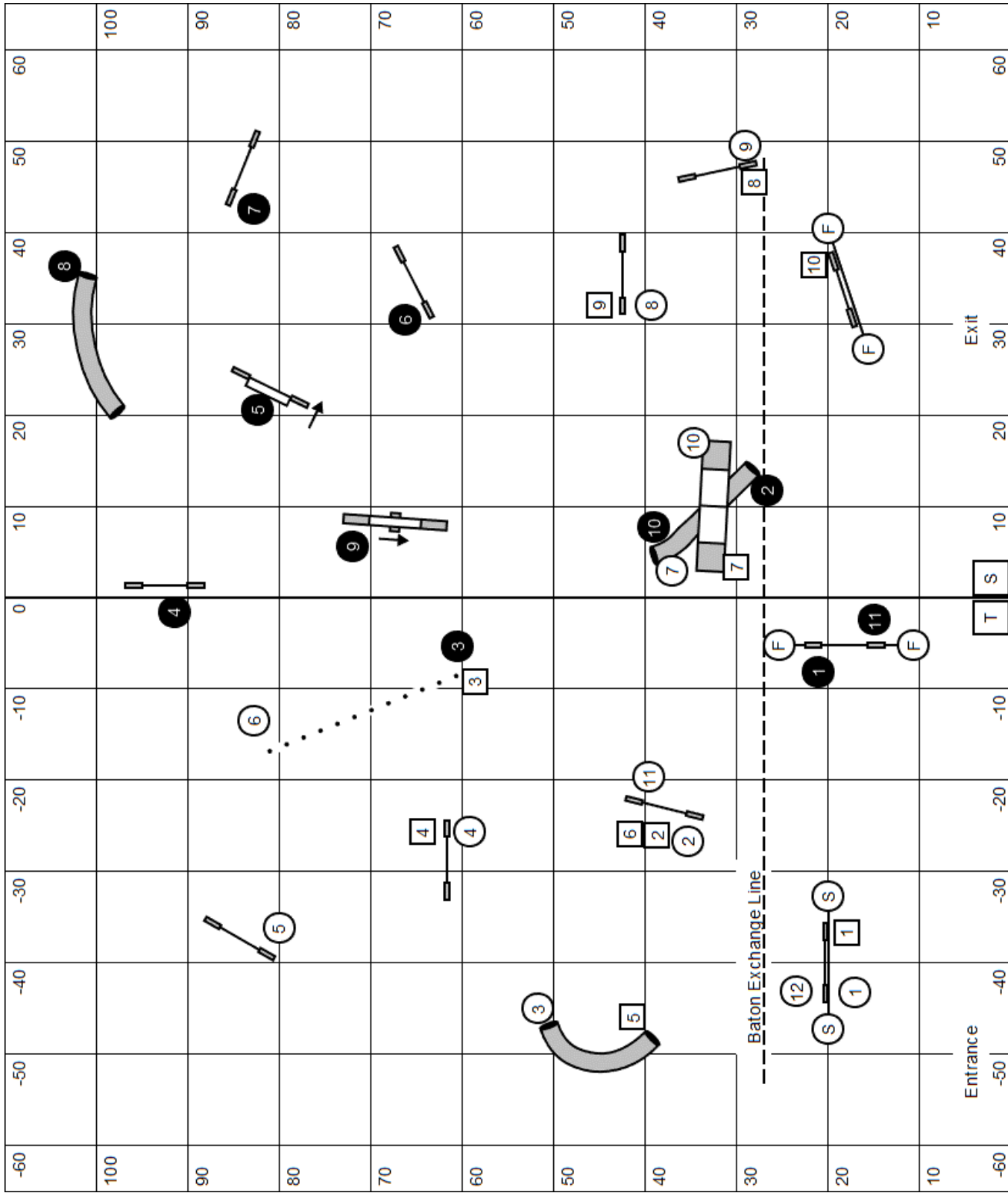
\*If odd-height dog is on a Team, they must do the Black Circles 1 - 11

#### **Performance Versatility Pairs**

- White Circles 1-12; Black Circles 1-11.

#### **General Rules – Team & PVP**

- Baton Exchange area as shown.
- Handlers and dogs not actively on course must remain behind Baton Exchange Line.
- Handlers and their dogs can be anywhere behind the dashed line for the baton exchange. (The line will not be present on the course but follows the edge of the A-frame for reference.)
- Handlers are responsible for their own leashes or leashes of their teammates - there will be no leash-runner.
- Dogs may be held in arms or on the ground, with or without a leash while teammates are on course.
- During the baton exchange, dogs must have all four feet on the ground, with or without leash. Leash must be off the dog prior to their first obstacle.
