

2023 Cynosport[®] World Games-Arrival and Crating

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Tennessee Miller Coliseum is a non-smoking facility. This includes all buildings, barns and outdoor areas.
- Listen for announcements and sign up for <u>Event Emails</u> on the <u>Cynosport website</u> for any changes to the schedule. The walk and run schedules will also be posted ringside.

LOADING/UNLOADING

- Competitors may unload their gear starting at **2pm on Tuesday, October 17** and at 6:30am the rest of the week.
- You may unload your vehicle close to your crating aisle, but you must then move your car and park in designated
 parking spaces. There is no parking between RVs and the barn <u>see map</u>. This must remain open pursuant to the fire
 code. Cars parked in this area will be towed at the owner's expense.

PARKING

- There is no fee for parking if you use the Competitor Entrance. Parking is on a first-come, first served basis. See map.
- Tennessee Miller Coliseum Staff parking is in front of the building on the upper level. Please do not use this area.

RV INFORMATION

- RV areas are available for arrivals beginning at 2pm on Tuesday, October 17.
- RV space information will be posted to the competitor information page on cynosport.com.
- Pumping is available on Friday for a fee. Envelopes will be available at check-in.

CRATING

- Reserved crating opens at 2pm on Tuesday, October 17.
- Overnight camping in stalls is not permitted.
- Electricity is available in some stalls. For safety reasons, electrical use is limited to fans and battery chargers only and must be unplugged overnight.
- Please crate only in your designated kennel area for the safety of your dog(s). If you are running multiple dogs, you may bring a crate to the ring only when your group runs.
- Please do not change your crating space, as all stalls have been reserved. Questions or issues on site should be directed to the staff at check-in and we will help you.
- Personal shade canopies may not be set up for individual crating.

CARTS AND MOBILITY ACCESS

- Personal, motorized conveyances are not allowed inside the competition area except for persons with disabilities (scooters/wheelchairs). Personal golf carts may be used to go back and forth between your car/RV, kenneling area, and the arena entrance but they must remain outside of the building and not block the fire lane.
- Please see a USDAA staff member at check-in for any other Mobility/Access assistance.

EXERCISE AREAS

- Dogs may be exercised in the large pastures behind the kenneling stalls.
- Remember to pick up after your dog and avoid having your dog potty on tents, trash cans, tables, chairs, etc.

SAFETY REMINDERS

- Remember to always keep valuables out of plain sight. All unattended property is left at your own risk.
- Personal chairs are not allowed ringside. Plentiful seating is available in the arena.
